In phonics this week, we have been learning the **oa** sound with Mr Graham, and some of us have even begun to learn our Phase 4 words – which have even more sounds in them!

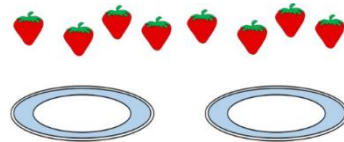
With Miss Slack-Humphrey, we have been revisiting Phase 2 sounds, practicing our oral blending!
