**Writing**

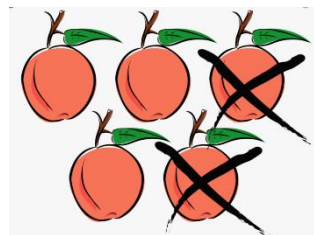

**Phonics**

This week, we have been looking at each of the vowel sounds and finding the different pronunciations for each sound – this has been very challenging, but the children have risen to the challenge brilliantly! We have also been focusing, as always, on split digraphs! Miss Slack-Humphrey's group have been continuing to develop their Phase 4 blending skills!

**Mathematics**

This week we have been focusing on subtraction. We began by subtracting numbers from 20, but have extended this to numbers to 100 – we even challenged ourselves to subtract a 2 digit number from 100 using a hundred square!
